Fossil Free SA is a ten-year-old established campaign working for an end to the fossil fuel industry in South Africa, particularly through fossil fuel divestment and challenging greenwashing in all its forms. Our core campaigns are for divestment by individuals and institutions, an end to greenwashing by the creative industries, and for bans on fossil fuel advertising.

Our management committee, drawn from members of our voluntary association, fulfils the functions of a board, taking overall responsibility for our governance and continued fulfilment of our mission, advising and assisting the senior management team and director.

In 2024, we are looking for two new candidates to join and refresh our current team of four.

These are unpaid, voluntary roles that would suit people with a passion for the environment and human rights, and ideally with knowledge and experience of organisational management and governance, especially in the non-profit sector. Knowledge, experience and connections in the financial sector would be particularly helpful to our divestment work; as would be an understanding of fundraising processes and solid connections in the philanthropic sector.

Time commitment: We meet three to four times a year for two hours online. We also liaise on an ongoing basis via WhatsApp updates to give you a clear view of what our team is busy with. We hope that you can join us in occasional in-person strategic planning sessions.
